INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITY FOR SOCIETY MEMBERS

PRIVATE LOANS PROGRAM

This program is an opportunity for members of our Society to help out with financing for the construction of the Lighthouse, our new building in the west end of Edmonton (see elsewhere in this issue for news on that!).

The support that the Society has provided to Emmanuel Home and seniors' living programs over the years has been tremendous. This new program allows for a new way to help by reducing our reliance on bank financing (and the interest costs!) as we work to complete the Lighthouse over the next 2 and a half years.

Basically, the Program allows for term investments of 1 to 5 years. Interest rates are set to be competitive with rates available at financial institutions.

Current terms, as of July 1, are as follows:

Minimum investment: \$25,000.00 Rates (fixed for term of investment):

1 - under 2 years: 2.0% 2 - under 3 years: 2.25% 3 - under 4 years: 2.5% 4 - 5 years: 2.75%

Interest Paid: December 31 each year, either paid to the investor or added to the investment (investor's option) Early redemption available with 90-day interest penalty
