Friendly Visits Volunteer

Provide companionship by visiting residents in supportive living with some cognitive impairments at Emmanuel Home. Support residents by providing one-on-one attention, assisting with mobility challenges, engage in small to large group social and recreational activities and other tasks as directed by recreation staff.

Client Group: Seniors in independent/supportive living with cognitive impairments

Risk Level: Low/medium

Time Commitment: One 2-hour shift per week, mornings, afternoons or early evening for a minimum of six months.

Duties/responsibilities:

- Support residents by providing one-on-one attention
- Assist residents with mobility challenges
- Engage residents in small to large group social and recreational activities
- Participate in other ancillary tasks as directed by recreation staff

Skills/qualifications:

- Caring, friendly and patient attitude
- Knowledge and/or willingness to learn about dementia care
- Well-developed interpersonal and communication skills
- Willingness and ability to take direction from staff
- Sensitivity to the needs and challenges of residents with various degrees of dementia

Orientation/training:

- One-hour orientation prior to first shift
- One-hour training prior to first shift

Supervision/evaluation:

- Supervisor: Resident Services Coordinator
- Annual evaluation with supervisor
